
[On 3/25/23]: Skier reported, "Came across debris of a recent skier-triggered slide near the top of Little Ellis in a small, protected, eastern facing gully around 7,500 '. Crown was $\sim 3.5-1.5^{\prime}$ deep, $\sim 35^{\prime}$ wide and it ran $\sim 150 '$. Ski tracks were observed near the top of the crown and next to a small hole near the surface $\sim 70$ from the crown where it looks like someone self extracted. No signal was found with a beacon search and my group felt that the one track from the hole must have been from the same skier as the track near the crown." Photo: R. Beck
